✓ check the line when you have completed the task: <u>Always:</u>

_____ Create and practice a safety plan within the community, family and neighbors.

_____ Prior to hurricane season, seasonal residents' property must be secured.

_____ Have someone assigned to protect your property.

_____ If a person is concerned with their property, know that Sentry CAN NOT be your contact place. Find someone prior to the storm to keep an eye on your property.

_____ Back up your computer.

_____ Shutters are not required, but an option for residents at your cost.

_____ Consider having on hand a battery-operated radio and batteries, and battery operated lanterns with sufficient batteries.

_____ If you have a generator, does it work and have fuel?

If a hurricane is expected to land in Sarasota:

_____ Assemble a packet of vital information if you must evacuate: Driver license or ID card, health insurance card, car's proof of insurance and registration, money.

_____ Have sufficient medications, food, water, and pet supplies on hand.

_____ Blasts will update as long as possible telling of storm pending; there may be no internet or electricity, so always keep track of weather during hurricane season.

____ Neighbors contact neighbors to ensure safety; consider staying together.

_____ Consider the life of food in the refrigerator or freezer in case of electrical power disruption, especially if you are seasonal.

_____ Plan on no electrical power, Wi-Fi or television.

_____ Plan on there not being air conditioning.

When the hurricane is imminent:

_____ Implement all of your storm preparations.

_____ Stay away from windows; the center of the home or in the bathroom is usually the safest, or seek a county shelter.

_____ Grounds Committee, turn off pumps to north and south irrigation systems, then turn them back on after a safe time has passed.

Residents Actions After a storm:

- _____ Check for safety of all residents.
- _____ Take pictures of the damage for insurance purposes.
- _____ Choose a place to pile debris.
- _____ Clear streets to let emergency vehicles pass.
- _____ If volunteers are cleaning up the debris, NO CHAIN SAWS ARE ALLOWED.
- _____ Protect property from further damage.
- _____ Document what was damaged.
- _____ Save receipts and photos of damage and repair.
- _____ Board, ASAP contact and work with insurance adjustor.
